- **LARGEST HOSPITAL IN AMERICA.** Ranked No. 1 in the nation for inpatient admissions by the *American Hospital Association*. With over 16,000 employees, Florida Hospital is proud to serve the residents and guests of Orlando, the No. 1 tourist destination in the world.
- **AMERICA'S HEART HOSPITAL.** Ranked No. 1 in the nation for number of heart procedures performed each year. Over 21,900 cases last year alone. By way of comparison, Florida Hospital performed 24% more procedures than Mayo Clinic and 35% more than Cleveland Clinic. Florida Hospital was named "America's Heart Hospital" by *MSNBC* for being the No. 1 hospital fighting America's No. 1 killer—heart disease.
